PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

The City of Herrin will hold a public hearing on August 24, 2026, at 5:45 p.m., at Herrin City Hall, 300 N. Park Avenue, Herrin, Illinois, to provide interested parties an opportunity to express their views on the proposed federally funded Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) project. Persons with disabilities or non-English speaking persons who wish to attend the public hearing and need assistance should contact Shelly Huggins, City Clerk, 300 N. Park Avenue, Herrin, Illinois 62948, (618) 942-3175, no later than August 21, 2026. Every effort will be made to make reasonable accommodations for these persons.

On or about August 27, 2026, the City of Herrin intends to apply to the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity for a grant from the State CDBG program. This program is funded by Title 1 of the federal Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended. These funds are to be used for a community development project that will include the following activities: replacement of approximately 3,091 linear feet of existing 6-inch cast iron water main with new 6-inch PVC water main, new water meters and service reconnections, fire hydrants, valves, service lines, sidewalk and pavement replacement, and related improvements along West Monroe Street from 20th Street to 30th Street. The total amount of CDBG funds to be requested is \$969,047.90. The amount of CDBG funds proposed to be used for activities that will benefit low-to-moderate income persons is \$749,655.46. The City of Herrin also proposes to expend \$0.00 in non-CDBG funds on the project.

Information related to this project will be available for review prior to the public hearing as of August 17, 2026 at Herrin City Hall, 300 N. Park Avenue, Herrin, Illinois, between the hours of 8:00

a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Interested citizens are invited to provide comments regarding these issues either at the public hearing or by prior written statement. Written comments should be submitted to Shelly Huggins, City Clerk, City of Herrin, 300 N. Park Avenue, Herrin, Illinois 62948, no later than August 24, 2026, in order to ensure placement of such comments in the official record of the public hearing proceedings. A plan to minimize displacement and provide assistance to those displaced has been prepared by the City of Herrin and is also available to the public. This project will result in no displacement of any persons or businesses.
